Who are we?

B.R.I.D.G.E. Homeschool Community is a group of homeschooling families who are united to Build, Reflect, Inspire, Dream, Gather, & Explore. Our group is centered around providing enrichment activities which serve as the catalyst to build relationships in the community. By joining B.R.I.D.G.E. Homeschool Community, you are agreeing to work as a team to help serve our group. This may be through sharing trip/class ideas, sharing a skill/hobby in a class, planning games, booking guest speakers, etc. The B.R.I.D.G.E. Homeschool Community Board reserves the right to approve or deny any lesson or activity that will be conducted.

Membership:

Sick Child Policy:

Please refrain from participating in B.R.I.D.G.E. Homeschool Community activities if you or anyone in your home is showing symptoms of a virus. This includes, but is not limited to, any respiratory virus, stomach virus, conjunctivitis, chicken pox, strep, staph, etc. In the event of a widespread sickness outbreak, meetings may be canceled.

Rules/Discipline:

- Each parent must take responsibility for their own child(ren). Drop-offs are NOT permitted.
- We realize that parents are excited to visit with their friends, but the children should remain our top priority.
- We do not tolerate bullying, name-calling, foul language, or any other behavior that would cause physical or emotional injury to others.
- Problems, disputes, hurt feelings, etc. should only be discussed with the involved parties. If there are any concerns/complaints which cannot be solved privately, please bring them to the attention of leadership.

Respect Facilities:

Our hosting facilities include, but are not limited to Bible Baptist Church of Danville, which graciously allows us to use their building free of charge. Bible Baptist requests that there be no smoking, vaping, or alcohol on or around the church property. Children are not left unattended outside in the parking lot. Also, dancing and non-Christian music are not permitted in the facilities. A love offering for the church will be collected annually.

Arrival/Departure Policy:

Punctuality for sponsored events is expected. It is imperative that we begin and end at our scheduled time to get the most from our events and have adequate time to clean-up during our allotted time at the facilities.

Inclement Weather Policy:

In the event of inclement weather, classes may be canceled. You will be contacted via phone, email, and/or Facebook.

Parent Involvement Policy:

- B.R.I.D.G.E. Homeschool Community is a parent-led co-op.
- Child drop-offs are NOT permitted under any circumstance.
- Communication with the board members is vital for the co-op's success. If something comes up, and you are not able to make it to an event, activity, or class, please be in contact with Rebecca Mobley. RSVPing to events and classes is imperative for planning purposes. We want to ensure each child is able to fully participate. We understand sickness occurs, weather creates barriers, etc. All that is asked is that you communicate with the board members. If you know that you will no longer be attending the co-op, please let Rebecca Mobley know; there is a waiting list of families eager to join.
- As the parent/guardian, **you are REQUIRED to sign up for at least one teaching AND one co-teaching position.**
 - You must teach in your child's class (classes are arranged by age). If you have more than one child, please pick one child's class to teach.
 - Each class day will revolve around a theme. Choose your first, second, and third choices for the days/themes that you feel equipped to teach.
 - Let the board members know what materials you need at least two weeks in advance. This ensures that you are able to receive them in a timely manner. Reimbursement for purchased materials is accepted (within reason).
 - Prepare for approximately an hour and a half worth of teaching.
 - You will be 100% supported. You can always ask clarifying questions, advice, tips, etc.
- The B.R.I.D.G.E. schedule is subject to change. Please be flexible as obstacles arise throughout the year.
- If you have any extenuating circumstances preventing you from teaching, please contact Rebecca Mobley.

Responsibilities of the teacher:

- Work in unison with the co-teacher.
- Prepare a lesson/activity that follows the predetermined theme of the day that you are assigned.
- Ask for help when needed. Let the board members know what materials you need. We are more than happy to get them for you.
- Emphasize students working together, student engagement, and fun.
- Ensure the lessons/discussions/activities do not violate the core beliefs of Bible Baptist Church of Danville. They have graciously allowed us to use their facilities, and we want to remain respectful. There is a zero-tolerance policy on the violation of Bible Baptist Church of Danville's beliefs, as it will result in B.R.I.D.G.E. losing the use of their facilities.

Responsibilities of the co-teacher:

- Work in unison with the teacher.
- Help prepare a lesson/activity that follows the predetermined theme of the day that you are assigned.
- Help facilitate students working together, student engagement, and fun.
- Be prepared to assist the teacher in any way during the lesson/activity.

Extracurriculars:

This year, B.R.I.D.G.E. is offering enrichment activities after our regularly scheduled co-op time has ended. These are optional and will be offered from 12:00pm-1:00pm. Parents are expected to stay on the premises while the students participate in the extracurriculars. Each extracurricular will take place once per month on a rotating schedule.

- P.E. – this extracurricular is open to students in groups 1, 2, 3, and 4. It will consist of group activities that will take place either at the church or the park. We will be primarily meeting in two age groups (groups 1 & 2, groups 3 & 4), but occasionally it will be all age groups in one activity.
- Yearbook Club – this extracurricular is open to students in groups 3 and 4 only. These students will create a yearbook for the 2026-2027 school year. We will need photographers, writers, designers, and editors. You will be expected to create the yearbook, collaborate with all students who participate in this extracurricular, and take pictures throughout co-op meetings.
- Book Club – this extracurricular is open to students in groups 1, 2, 3, and 4. The students will be given a pre-selected book to read. Prior to the next month's meeting, they will read the book and come ready to discuss what they read. Younger students may have this book read to them.
- Nature Club – this extracurricular is open to students in groups 1, 2, 3, and 4. Our goal with this enrichment activity is to have a parent-led group that meets once per month at varying locations. The students will participate in hikes, nature talks and walks, and bird watching. This club allows students the opportunity to connect with nature in varying ways.

If your child is interested in any of the aforementioned extracurriculars, please list them below. There will be information given to interested students.

This year will be a trial run with the co-op's enrichment activities. We will not be adding any additional extracurriculars, but at the end of the year, we will have the opportunity to discuss next year's extracurricular activities, based on continued student interest and feedback.
